

OEPS POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR FOR LEARNING REWARD SYSTEM

Every term we continue to recognise students for their behavioural achievements at our *Positive Behaviour for Learning* (PBL) Assemblies. This system recognises when students reach certain milestone amounts of 'Yetis' (or Dojo points).

The acknowledgement levels are listed below:

Level	Requirement
PBL Medallion	400 Yetis + demonstrated outstanding behaviour
Platinum Certificate	400 Yetis
Gold Certificate	300 Yetis
Silver Certificate	200 Yetis
Bronze Certificate	100 Yetis

A reminder: at the end of each term we hold PBL assemblies to present students with any level/s they have reached. It is possible that students may achieve two levels during a term, for example – a student that finishes Term 1 with 95 Yetis and in the following term receives 105 Yetis (200 in total) and is awarded both Bronze and Silver at the end of Term 2 assembly. It is also possible for a student to have an assembly where they do not receive an award as during the term, they did not quite progress another level. This system provides students with clear reward targets and recognition for the various levels they achieve.

Useful information:

- There are four certificate levels, each requiring 100 Yetis.
- The final *PBL Medallion* level requires the student to receive 400 Yetis but also to meet Orange East's behavioural expectations to the highest level. (See *PBL Award Expectations Table* below). After the final Yeti/Dojo cut-off date in Term 4 the Principal, Assistant Principal, Class Teacher and School Learning Support Officer (if working in the relevant class) will meet to discuss students who have achieved Platinum level to assess if they have met the criteria to be awarded the final *PBL Medallion* level.
- Students who have achieved a new certificate level in Term 4 will be presented with their certificate at the PBL assemblies.
- Students who achieve the final *PBL Medallion* level will be presented with their special award at the School Presentation Day Ceremony.
